

ORDINANCE NO. 11-2020

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG CONSENTING TO THE REHABILITATION OF US ROUTE 40 (NATIONAL ROAD) BY THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF REYNOLDSBURG IN LICKING COUNTY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg in Licking County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has identified the need to rehabilitate of SFN 4502019 on US Route 40 (National Road) with the City of Reynoldsburg in Licking County. This work will be performed as part of PID 96320, Lic-US 40-00.14/02.65/06.80; and

WHEREAS, said portion of described project is within the Reynoldsburg City Council area of responsibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO, that:

- Section 1. Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.
- Section 2. The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project.
- Section 3. ODOT shall assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the necessary costs State's highway improvement project. In the event that the LPA requests certain features or appurtenances be included within the State's highway improvement project's design and construction, and which features and appurtenances are determined by the State and FHWA to not be necessary for the State's project, the LPA shall contribute one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of those items.
- Section 4. The LPA agrees that all rights-of-way required (if applicable) for the described Project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current state and federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs. The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocations, and reimbursements will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 65 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

Section 5. Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law including, but not limited to, Title 23 USC Section 116, provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project, shall maintain the right-of-way keeping it free of obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

Section 6. That upon adoption by Council, this ordinance shall be in effect thirty days following the signature by the Mayor.


